UPLOADING FILES TO A SERVER WITH FETCH

1. Your web address - or URI (Uniform Resource Identifier)

- Each student has space on our MATC server. It is where you will put all the exercises and websites you create in this class.
- You can look at your space in a browser by putting in your URI (using my name as an example):

2. Uploading files to your website with Fetch

- You will put your exercises and websites on the server using an FTP (file transfer protocol) software called **FETCH.**
- When you open Fetch, it will ask you for the :
 - · HOSTNAME,
 - USERNAME,
 - CONNECTION MODE and
 - · PASSWORD.
 - You fill them in, click connect and there you are.
- If you are logging in at school, you can click on the Favorites heart and the information will be filled in for you.
- Click the Put icon to put files on the internet; Click the Get icon to get them back.
- Or you can drag and drop
